From the Pastor's Desk...

Thy Word Have I Hid in My Heart

Last month we covered a Sunday message on Spiritual Warfare and in it I suggested a need for memorizing scripture. The need is really threefold:

1) Memorizing scripture helps us be at the ready when we are under attack. While we won't always have a Bible handy, if the Word is memorized, when the attack comes (not "if" but "when") we can then allow the Holy Spirit to draw from our memory to deal with the attack.

2) If we are out and about and an opportunity comes to share the gospel, a Bible again isn't always at hand, so having scripture memorized makes it easy to share scripture even though we can't turn to chapter and verse.

3) In the event that for whatever reason we no longer have access to the Word of God, we can still spend time in the scriptures as we recall what we have memorized.

Now, the next question is, what to memorize? Well, let me offer some suggestions based on the above.

Additionally, one could take an area in their life that tends to be a problem area, and memorize scripture related to it, such as Anger (Ephesians 4:26,27; James 1:19,20), Depression (Deuteronomy 31:8; Philippians 4:8), Being Judgmental (Matthew 7:1-5; 12:36,37) or any other area that one chooses to address through scripture.

Now let me add this at the end... I know that memorization is hard and not something most people like to do. However, once you have either memorized scripture and had it at the ready when a Bible wasn't at hand, or, once you have wished you had a scripture to quote when a Bible wasn't at hand, in either of these situations you will immediately realize the value of the hard work and the reward of putting scripture to memory. It will be well worth it, I assure you.
