From the Pastor's Desk... The Mark of a Disciple

February is the month that we have the "I Love Jesus" potluck at our church. Though this has gone by different names over the years, the content has remained largely the same as we recognize how much Jesus loves us, and because of that, we can then return that love to Him and to others. John put it this way in I John 4:19-21,

> "¹⁹ We love because he first loved us. ²⁰ If anyone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen cannot love God whom he has not seen. ²¹ And this commandment we have from him: whoever loves God must also love his brother."

The same author, John, also penned these words in John 13:35, about what Jesus had to say to His disciples concerning "love," "³⁵ By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."

Jesus said it very plainly... "By this" referring to the love that we exhibit for one another. Notice Jesus didn't say, "because you are good, because you are smart, because you are diligent, because you are _____ (and you fill in the blank). No, Jesus said this will be the mark, the identifier of my disciples, my followers; the love you show one another. Which brings us to a question for this month... Ask yourself, "Based on the love I show others, would people recognize me as a Jesus follower?" Think about that for a minute. Ponder upon it. Think about this past week- have you shown the love that would mark you as a disciple of Jesus Christ?

If the answer you have is "yes," then nothing further is needed except to keep on keeping on with what you are doing. If however, you have to say "no," I have been deficient in that showing of love, then two questions come to mind; why, and how do you get back on the right track once again? The why could be; too busy, overwhelmed, lack of care, or it was an oversight and I'll do better next time. None of those are really valid reasons, but at least you've identified the cause and can now make a course correction.

Getting back on track starts with I John 1:9 and the confession of our sin. Then, we need to make a conscious choice to love others, as Christ loves us. And once that choice is made, it needs to be put into practice. Who needs a touch of Jesus love around you? Someone lost? Someone sick? Someone burdened down? Having and showing love for others is not an option- it comes as an expectation from God. But remember, it's not loving in our strength, but in His strength. And no matter what the circumstance or who the person is, we can love them. Why? Because God desires it; it is the mark of a disciple.
